IRON ROCK TO RUN ROTAX MAX CHALLENGE IN 2006

February 1, 2006 – Austin, TX – Iron Rock Raceway is now sanctioned for the Rotax Max Challenge. The Rotax series will run concurrently with the Iron Rock Club Race series.



Participants must designate whether they intend to compete in East or West Coast Runoffs at the beginning of the season. To qualify for the 2006 East Coast Runoffs, racers must participate in at least four regional races before July 5, 2006. To qualify for the 2006 West Coast Runoffs, racers must participate in at least four regional races before July 31, 2006.

The top 15 from each coastal series will proceed to the 2006 Grand National to be held September 29th - October 1st at Miller Motorsports Park in Salt Lake City, Utah, and a chance to become a member of America's Team at the 2006 World Finals.

Rotax practice nights at Iron Rock are second and fourth Wednesday evenings at 6 pm and are open to both members and the public.

The series is composed of five categories:

- * Minimax Ages 9-12 255 lbs. minimum (kart, driver and gear)
- * Junior Ages 13-16 320 lbs. minimum (kart, driver and gear)
- * Senior Ages 16+ 365 lbs. minimum (kart, driver and gear)
- * Masters Ages 16+ 405 lbs. minimum (kart, driver and gear)
- * RM1 Ages 16+ 385 lbs. minimum (kart, driver and gear)

Front brakes optional for Junior, Senior and Masters. Required for RM1.

The Rotax Max Challenge is a CIK-approved and FIA-authorized series sanctioned under Rotax Max Challenge Sporting Regulations and Rotax Max Challenge Technical Regulations. (For more information on these regulations or other Rotax information, visit <http://www.rmaxchallenge.com>).
